



Dave Tollington, Senior Vice President, Domestic Division, is very optimistic saying, "This is probably the busiest we've ever been as far as domestic artists are concerned."

Just released is the debut of Saskatoon native Glen Stace. His self-produced album, Buddha Hotel, and the single Runaround is doing well at radio.

Formerly of The Headpins, Darby Mills' solo album is in stores this week and the first single, Cry To Me, is exploding at radio. "We always believed in Darby," says Tollington,

Young M.C. signs exclusively to Capitol

Capitol Records U.S. President, Hale Milgrim, has announced the recent signing of rap artist Young M.C. to a long term, worldwide, exclusive recording contract with Capitol Records.

All former disputes involving Young M.C. and Capitol with his former label, Delicious Vinyl and Island Records, were apparently amicably resolved May 24th, 1991. Representatives of the parties reportedly executed an undisclosed settlement that cleared the way for Milgrim's announcement.

Glass Tiger /EMI Music sign co-publishing deal

EMI Music Publishing Canada has signed Glass Tiger to an exclusive co-publishing deal which also incorporates compositions written by individual members and the band as a whole.

The band's latest album, Simple Mission, released on the Capitol label, is now platinum plus in Canada. Rhythm Of Your Love, the second single taken from the album, is now in the Top 30 of the RPM Singles chart after only three weeks on release.

The band recently returned from a promotion tour of Europe and dates are now being pencilled in for a tour with Rod Stewart. The My Town track on the Tiger's album features a guest shot by Stewart, who shares vocals with Alan Frew.

Frost can now be heard coast-to-coast in Canada, as host of Overnight, on Vancouver's CFMI-FM, Red Deer's CIZZ-FM, Winnipeg's CJKR-FM, Q107 in Toronto and OZ-FM in Newfoundland. Further affiliate annoucements are expected shortly.


EMI Classics to release McCartney Oratorio

Paul McCartney moves into the Masters class with the EMI Classics recording of his Liverpool Oratorio to be recorded live at the world premiere performances in Liverpool Anglican Cathedral (June 28 & 29).

McCartney is regarded as the most successful popular composer of his generation, but Liverpool Oratorio is his first venture into the classical idiom. The work was written by McCartney in collaboration with composer Carl Davis, best known for his film and TV music. There are eight movements with a timing of 90 minutes and involves more than 300 performers. The story is based on McCartney's early life in Liverpool.

Written for traditional instrumental forces and classically-trained voices, the work was commissioned by the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Society to celebrate its 150th anniversary. McCartney himself will be in the audience at the first performances. Soloists performing the work are soprano Dame Kiri Te Kanawa, mezzo-soprano Sally Burgess, tenor Jerry Hadley and bass-baritone Willard White. The Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra and the Choir and the Choristers of Liverpool Cathedral are conducted by Carl Davis.

The London premiere has been firmed for July 7 at the Royal Festival Hall. Performances in North America are being pencilled in for next year. A BBC-Picture Music International documentary on the creation of the McCartnev work will be broadcast in the U.K. in October of this year.

Visual Vinyl, based in Owen Sound, Ontario, has released a new, limited edition picture disc of Lee Aaron. The 12 inch, one-sided vinyl disc contains the same four tracks that were on her first picture disc released in 1983. These tracks were originally released on Aaron's debut album for the Freedom label.

Although the songs are the same, the pictures are different. Only 1,000 copies of this limited edition have been pressed. They are avilable only from Visual Vinyl and carry a price tage of \$16.95.

The four songs included are Frank Soda's I Like My Rock Hard, Under Your Spell, written by Aaron, Dave Alpin and Gene Stout, Rick Santers' Lonely For Your Love, and Willy Dixon's I Just Wanna Make Love To You.

Ontario Place setting for World Beat music festival

Ontario Place will present World Beat, an international music festival on two stages running weekends from June 29 to Aug. 11. A helicopter pad, situated on the West Island and rarely used, will be the stage for concerts by Siyakha, Flying Bulgar Klezmer Band, Hip Hop Revue, Bongcongonistas. The concerts will present a mix of South African township jive, Latin salsa, calypso, rap, reggae and other sounds of what is described as "Ontario's cultural mix."

The Festival Stage, a 1,000 seat permanent, covered bandshell amphitheatre will also be used, and will feature performances by Staro Selo, Nazka, Hands On, Saint "O" and others.

World Beat is being programmed by Billy Bryans, a veteran in the business, beginning in the sixties with M.G. & The Escorts, but probably better known as the co-founder of the Parachute Club.

Admittance to all World Beat performances is free.

Grapes and Brooks cross paths in London

Capitol's rock band The Grapes Of Wrath, met on of the label's top country acts, Garth Brooks, in London, England.

The Grapes, a popular B.C. rock and pop band, were in London's Abbey Road Studios with producer John Leckie, who has been associated with Simple Minds, XTC and Stone Roses. They were mixing These Days, which was produced at Vancouver's Mushroom Studios. This is their fourth Capitol album, which is scheduled for a July 19 release in Canada. A broadcaster in trouble ...? Broadcasters have usually been careful not to air their dirty laundry in public, but the laundry in one case has been growing like topsy and it's beginning

to spill out over the toilet seat. Someone even stole an internal memo, that should never have been written. A major player might have to retire. (EC: Naw! Impossible! I'll believe it when I see it . . . !)

Get loaded at the movies . . . ! If baseball fans can make jerks of themselves, why not movie buffs? It was bad enough going to the movies and having to put up with the slurping coke suckers and popcorn addicts, but now it's going to be beer and wine. (EC: Can bad breath stand between an obvious romance . . . ?)

Watch for a PR surprise . . . ! If everything goes according to plan, Toronto's PR people, the well-heeled and not so well-heeled, will get a shaking out. PR in Toronto is on the verge of going big time . . . if everything goes according to plan. (EC: That means the list of beautiful people will be cut in half . . . !)

The industry people in La Belle Province are apparently a little annoyed that a couple of French-language superstars are also gaining superstar status in the English world. Blue Rodeo, now that's a draw . . . ! Blue Rodeo was the only act to pack the Ontario Place Forum to capacity this year. . . and that's 7,000 plus. Hold on, there's more. They did it the second night as well. That reminds me of the time when that high-priced manipulator, who holds down a position of trust for a major, MAJOR, annual showcase, told me, rather emphatically, "It's necessary to have foreign stars on the show, because they make the Canadian acts look good!" 

Founded in 1949, CMPA is the largest association of music publishers in Canada. The organization promotes and protects the interest of composers and publishers of popular and serious music in Canada and has taken a leading role in the ongoing process of reform to Canada's copyright legislation.

Last year's winner in the Rock category was the David Tyson and Christopher Ward penning of Black Velvet, performed by Alannah Myles. The runners-up were (first) Love Is, also written by Tyson and Ward and performed by Myles, and (second) Tom Cochrane's Big League, which he recorded with Red Rider.

In the Adult Contemporary/Pop category, David Shaw's Love Makes No Promises, performed by Candi was the big winner. The runners-up in this category were (first) the Andrew Cash and Chuck Angus penning of Cash's recording of Boomtown, and (second) Rita MacNeil's original We'll Reach The Sky.

The Country winner was another MacNeil original, I'll Accept The Rose. Runners-up were (first) Gary Fjellgaard's The Moon Is Out To Get Me, a Fjellgaard original, and (second) Sure Looks Good, co-written by Tracey Brown and Randall Prescott and recorded by Family Brown.

The station's programming also includes regular specialty shows like the cultural report Vancouver Live, local talent showcasing of The New Music Hour, a weekly hour of comedy during Laughline, and its version of the ever popular relationship shows, Sex, Lies and Audiotape, hosted by family therapist Rhona Raskin.

The new Vancouver station is committed to the development of young Canadian talent in the greater Vancouver area. The station is 100% digital and plays all of its music from either compact disc or digital audio tape only.

White's Momnipotent offers relief to parents

If Nancy White is not yet a household name, she should be because that's exactly where her new release Momnipotent - Songs For Weary Parents should be, in the household. If you're a parent, or plan to be one, this satirical look at the joys, and sometimes hassles, of raising a child is for you.

Released on The Children's Group label and distributed by A&M Records of Canada, this collection is a bit of a departure from what White has done in the past and are not nursery rhymes but songs for full-time, slightly exhausted parents.

White is known as Canada's Voice Of Liberal Guilt and has been heard on CBC's Sunday Morning show, for which she has written hundreds of topical songs since 1976. At

Big House shoots video at Hamilton's Tivoli

Big House picked Hamilton, Ontario's historic Tivoli Theatre as the setting for the video shoot of Dollar In My Pocket (May 11 & 12), the first single taken from their self-titled debut album. The single will be released Aug. 23.

All members of the band were actively involved in the production of the video, from writing the script and choosing the theatre to supplying props, costumes and actors. They worked closely with Boomtown president/comanager Stephen Prendergast and video director Harry Lake, who has been associated in similar projects with Stray Cats and Queen.

Stranger Than Fiction showcases at Ultrasound

Intrepid recording artists, Stranger Than Fiction, played Toronto's Ultrasound, May 22nd, to showcase their debut release The Sound Of Roses Burning.

Stranger Than Fiction are headed by the brother and sister team of John and Anne Beadle. They've been playing together, in various permutations, for about 6 years and their musical styles encompass a variety of musical influences; from acoustic rock to jazzy ballads.

Stranger Than Fiction recently released a single/video titled Rock The Cradle, which questions the motives of modern day TV evangelists. The video was produced and directed by Keith Harrick of L.C.A. Productions. The next cut slated for release is What's A Girl To Do.

one time she was writing four to five songs a week, with topics ranging anywhere from Trudeau to the Pope's visit to Canada to the Moral Majority. She still writes for Sunday Morning but now at a pace of about one song a week. If it sounds like she has a nose for journalism it's because she was a reporter/columnist for a few Maritime newspapers before breaking into showbiz.

Since starting out as a folk singer, White has racked up an impressive, and versatile resume. She has performed live across Canada as well as Scotland, Germany and Nicaragua. She has also performed in cabarets and appeared on such television shows as Sharon, Lois & Bram's Elephant Show and on her own special entitled Nancy White's Musical Ride, among others. She has also won three ACTRA Awards (one for Sunday Morning, two for the radio special Lies My Mother Told Me) and has also released two previous albums, Unexpected (CBC Enterprises) and Civil Service Songwiter (Attic Records) along with a slue of cassettes

The list could go on and on, but most important through all this is her gift for making people laugh. "People like to laugh," says White, "and they also like material they can identify with." Momnipotent is the result of keeping a sort of musical diary of the funny times that child rearing offers. White is married to her pianist and arranger Doug Wilde and together they have two daughters. When she had enough material together, she decided to press an album. She released it herself and sold it through the mail and bookstores until The Children's Group got in touch with her and put it out.

The results have been very positive and White has received plenty of mail from parents who have really enjoyed her album. "I don't think a lot of people are writing material that relates to what parents are going through," says White. Some people are just grateful to know they're not the only ones who've gone through this."

I'm Babbling, the opening tune, chronicles what happens when someone is trying to listen to the news and tend to the children at the same time, resulting in failure to keep up with current events. Child On Board is about those silly signs that are grossly misunderstood. "It's really hard to drive a car when someone's screaming right behind your head and you want to comfort them," White adds. Other tracks include such titles as It's So Chic To Be Pregnant At Christmas, Everything Turn To Ratshit In My Life and Leonard Cohen's Never Gonna Bring My Groceries In. There's something in it for every parent and even teenagers. "I think it should go into highschool washrooms in a dispenser, because kids who hear this certainly won't want kids right away," White jokes.

White's Momnipotent can be found in the Toronto area at Sam's, Parentbooks, A Child's Garden, Toronto Women's Bookstore, The Children's bookstore and the new HMV superstore.

Tops in the 90's..? R.E.M. holds the top spot on the Albums chart for the eighth straight week. That makes Out Of Time one of the top albums so far this decade. The only albums to hold the top spot longer in the 90's have been Sinead O'Connor's I Do Not Want What I Haven't Got (15 weeks), and Phil Collins'... But Seriously (10 weeks).

None in the Top 20. In order for an album to hit No. 1, it invariably has to have a Top 20 song to give it the exposure. R.E.M.'s Out Of Time is no exception, Losing My Religion keeps the No. 6 spot. The last album to hit No. 1 without a Top 20 song is Paul Simon's The Rhythm Of The Saints (The Obvious Child peaked at No. 28). Since the album is still out, it could yet yield a Top 20 song, so name the album previous to that one to reach No. 1 without scoring a major hit? Hint: if you can remember this album from a few years back, it makes logical sense.

Twice the action. It is a growing phenomenon. Having two songs out simultaneously. Usually, they are in different formats to give an album maximum exposure. It happened recently with Candi & The Backbeat and now Blue Rodeo. What Am I Doing Here climbs to No. 35, while After The Rain rises 15 spots to No. 75.


Chart explosion . . . Amy Grant's Every Heartbeat gets a big debut this week. It enters at No. 59. Most weeks, that would be high enough to get the top entry, but not this week. Tom Petty & The Heartbreakers' Learning To Fly bows way up at No. 39 and even that isn't the highest debut. That honour belongs to Bonnie Raitt's Something To Think About. Just two week's after Glass Tiger's The Rhythm Of Your Love had the highest debut of the year, Something To Think About goes a few notches more, entering at No. 31.

The Albums chart also! The Hit Tracks chart isn't the only chart with high entries. On the Albums chart, Skid Row's Slave To The Grind debuts at No. 18. Two others also enter in the Top 50. Van Halen's For Unlawful Carnal Knowledge debuts at No. 43, and Natalie Cole's Unforgettable With Love at No. 49.

Hard Rock ballads... Many hard rock bands have done at least one ballad to gain wide-spread radio exposure. Scorpions are no exception. Wind Of Change is easily the band's biggest radio hit. The largest area of support for the song comes from Quebec, where the song has hit, or come close to hitting, the top at: CKOI Montreal, FM 93 Quebec City, CFIX Chicoutimi, as well as the video channel MusiquePlus.

The no-hit album. The last album to reach No. 1 without having a Top 20 song was A Very Special Christmas in December of 1987. Since it was a charity album, no single was released, but received widespread airplay on a number of tracks. The album continues to receive plenty of exposure every December.

TAJ MAHAL - Rock & Soul Like Never Before Private Music - 2081-2-P

What better way for contemporary music to catch up with Taj Mahal than with Daryl Hall, John Oates, the Pointer Sisters (Anita, Ruth, June), Dr. John, The Hooters, D.J. Jazzy Jeff, Paul Barrere of Little Feat and David Lindley. That's a pretty impressive lineup of contributors, but it's still Mahal's awesome vocal approach that puts this unique entertainment package into perspective. All that's needed now are adventuresome programmers who might like to overwhelm their listeners. Key are Blues With A Feeling, written by blues harmonica virtuoso "Little Walter" Jacobs, Take A Giant Step, a writing collaboration between Carole King and Gerry Goffin, and an exceptional John Martyn penning of Love Up. 98DA are a five-man, independent outfit hailing from Toronto that dish out a brand of punk blues that is very refreshing. Comprised of guitarists Dave Clark and Rich Osley, bassist Rick Barnes, drummer Jeff Shoebridge and vocalist Mars, 98DA's second release, Gun to Head Blues has been receiving favourable reviews from fans and getting airplay on college radio in both Canada and the States. This four song mini-cassette was recorded at Playroom by Ken Dirschl and is a strong indication that this band geared towards bigger and better things in the future. (Cassette reviewed) - PF



SKID ROW - Hard Rock Slave To The Grind Atlantic-CD-82242-P


The Skids are back with their second release on the Atlantic label. Produced by Micheal Wagener, Slave To The Grind is a far cry from their self-titled debut album in 1989. Sebastian Bach's powerful vocals do nothing but compliment their new punk/rock sound.

Judging from this album, I'd say that Skid Row is out to be heard. If you thought the first was loud and slightly obnoxious, you haven't heard nothing yet. Recorded in South Africa during Nelson Mandela's release, it is a powerful collection of world music written by Capek, with the help of Carole Pope and the Holy Jerusalem Choir among others. 


JEAN LUC PONTY -World Music Tchokola Epic EK 47378-H

Australian country might seem a little foreign to Nashville, but James Blundell has that country/folk roots vocal charm that defies the usual categorizing as traditional, contemporary or what have you. His country is perhaps a little more folkier than what North Americans are accustomed to, but that's what adds the magic to these tracks. He's a master story-teller and he has a vocal confidence and projection that immediately puts him in the winner's circle, whether it be for country or AC. Blundell got the nod last year as Male Vocalist from the Australian Country Music Association, and The Blue Heeler, now charting in Canada, won key Country Song of the Year. Also are Age Of Grace, Rock Me and Across The Mile. (CD reviewed) - WG



SEAL - Dance/Rock Seal ZTT CD 74557-P

This young artist hails from the UK and his blend of heavy dance and picturesque verse is a winning combination. The album never gives up

There are plenty of trademark horn lines in songs like Who Do You Think You Are and Attitude Dance, which is reminiscent of What Is Hip from days gone by. For those in a more subtle mood, there are some serious ballads in You Can't Fall Up (You Just Fall Down) and How Could This Happen To Me. 


ALAN JACKSON - Country Don't Rock The Jukebox Arista - ARCD-8681-N

The Tembo recording star will be joined on centre stage by special guest artists Kimberley Richards and David Hutchins. Baker is currently charting with her Tembo track, I Should Have Put A Hold On Love, and Richards and Hutchins with their Trilogy tracks, Something Special and These Five Medals, respectively.

This track is included on Capitol's June Country CD compilation #39, and was taken from her album Bottom Line. The album was produced by Billy Joe Walker Jr. and recorded in Nashville.

The Kentucky Headhunters have been firmed for two Ontario dates, June 27th at Toronto's Massey Hall and the 28th at Hamilton Place. They were originally booked for the Copp's Coliseum Concert Bowl in

Hamilton.

Bookshop's Gilles Godard releases another in his CD single series, showcasing eleven new and established recording acts: Jules (Callin' You Baby), Susan Jacks (Sweet New Love), Hal Bruce (I'm Going Home), Ronnie Prophet (The Feeling Of Love), Kelita (Merry Go Round), The Bobby Lalonde Band (Somebody Painted My Hometown), Shucks (Highway), Dianne Ticknor (You And Yesterday), Donna & Leroy (Street Hearts), Debbie Drummond (Eyes For This Guy), and Eddie Eastman (Runaway Heart). 
